Mrs. Hacket's first grade has been working on a social studies unit related to Goods & Services. The unit started out the unit by learning about various goods / services. Then, we created a template for what kind of store they could create. Some chose to make a service (dance studio, police station etc.) and some chose to make a store that sold goods (Candy store, video store, hat store). The students designed posters for their stores, wrote and filmed commercials and finally set up stores at their desks for our culminating activity of pretending to shop and visit each other's stores. Along the way the class also learned about how families choose what to spend money on (needs and wants). To emphasize this each student was given only \$3 to use while "shopping". Once their money was spent they were able to browse and window shop. They had to think carefully about where they were going to spend their money! They all enjoyed making their stores and pretending to be shop owners!










