






First graders are sporting green to celebrate St. Patrick's Day!






Second grade used the engineering design process to make leprechaun traps today!








This week, fifth grade students took to investigating and exploring the math concepts surrounding Pi! Pi Day, traditionally held on March 14, was postponed a day due to our most recent snow days, but the fun was not lost! On Thursday, fifth graders participated in reading about Pi, investigating how and why Pi is used, and solving problems having to do with Pi! Students used measurement, division, graphing, along with other math concepts to work on activities throughout the day. Also, the yearly Pi digit memorization contest was held in both classrooms. From Mr. Sullivan's class the four students who memorized the most digits of Pi were: Riley (71 digits), Tyce (71 digits), Yasiyn (47 digits), and Chris (43). From Mrs. St Pierre's class: Teddy (117 digits), Hannah (116 digits), and Annie (74 digits). In addition, students also created line artwork using the digits of Pi, and a city skyline using graphing and watercolors.

Tim Kelly from Princeton FD will be back to implement the SAFE program here at TPS. He was here earlier in the year working with kindergarten and first grade.


