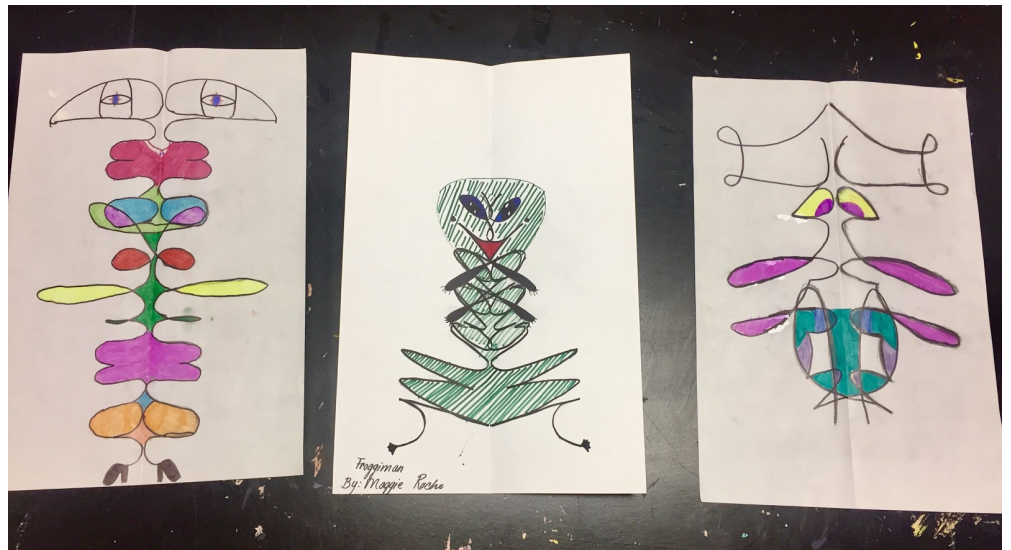
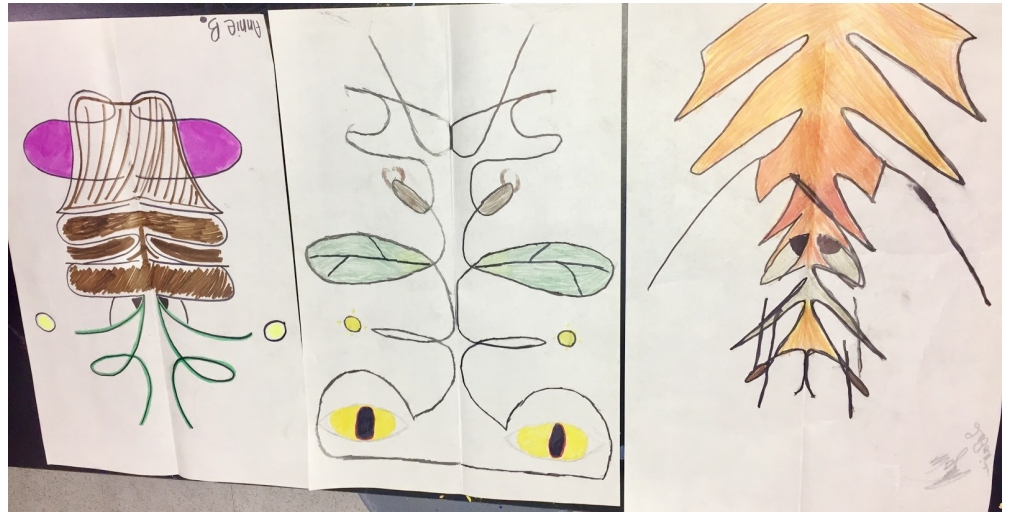








In Art class, grades 4 and 5 have been working on their "Symmetrical Creative Cursive Creature" project :) They write their names in cursive using a charcoal pencil, and apply pressure to the folded piece of paper with their name inside. The pressure creates a transfer of their name so that it is mirrored on the opposite side of the folded paper. The students use markers and colored pencils to create a creature from their name.





Grades 6-8 are working on finishing up their Hero Art project.

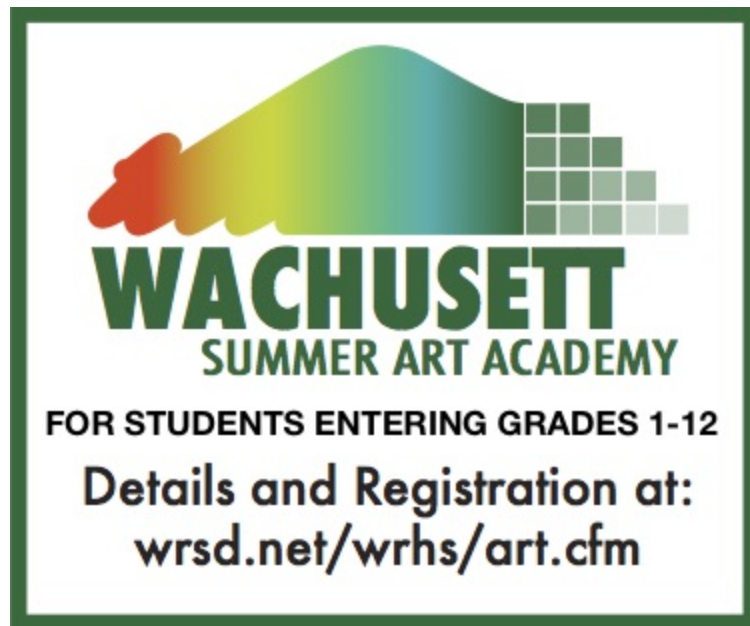

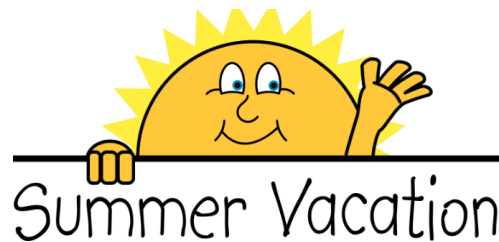

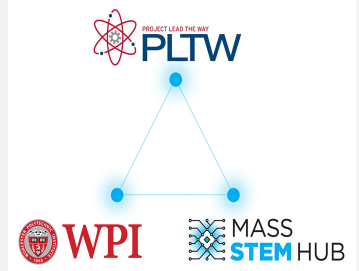
